## Did you know?

"What Child Is This," also known as "Greensleeves", was written by William Chatterton Dix (1837 - 1898). Mr. Dix was a hymn writer who also wrote carols. The three verses were actually taken from Mr. Dix' poem, "The Manger Throne", and harmonized with a famous melody known as "Greensleeves."

**God Rest Ye Merry, Gentlemen** is an English traditional Christmas carol. Although the author is unknown, the melody was published in minor mode by William B. Sandys in 1833.

The First Noël is a traditional classical English carol, most likely from the 18th century, although possibly earlier. The word Noel comes from the French word Noël meaning "Christmas", from the Latin word natalis "birthday". It was first published in Carols Ancient and Modern (1823) and Gilbert and Sandys Carols (1833), both of which were edited by William B. Sandys and arranged, edited and with extra lyrics written by Davies Gilbert Hymns and Carols of God.


"Hark! The Herald Angels Sing" is a Christmas carol that first appeared in 1739, and written by Charles Wesley. In 1955, English musician William H. Cummings adapted Felix Mendelssohn's secular music from Festgesang to fit his lyrics to "hark! The Herald Angels Sing". Mr. Wesley envisioned the song being sung to the same tune as his song "Christ the Lord is Risen Today".

"Silent Night" Joseph Mohr wrote the lyrics of the carol, was born December 11<sup>th</sup>, 1792, in the city of Salzburg, where he also spent his childhood and early youth. He joined the priest seminary and was ordained as priest in 1815.


"Well Lord", I said, "here I go, stepping out in faith." I was on my way with a humbled heart, traveling many miles in the fog without passing a single vehicle.


